Latest information on the activities and developments under the Eco-industrial Park project in Andhra Pradesh.

## The ASEM HRDP web-based Training Management Platform is a tool to organise and structure all measures and events for HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

The HRD-Platform facilitates efficient web-based management of capacity building programmes. It is deployed by an internal expert network for the ASEM coordination teams, training managers and the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India. It gives full or password protected access to all course material, concepts, tools and instruments of capacity building in environment and sustainable development.

- to inform about upcoming trainings and workshops with detailed information

**Eco-Industrial Estates in Andhra Pradesh**

The Eco-Industrial Estate Programme has been taken up by CPCB with the overall objective of minimizing conflicts between 'industry' and 'environment' while ensuring:

- Industrial development compatible to social, environmental and economic needs for achieving sustainable development
- Improved economic performance of industries and investment safety
- Harmonious development around the estates

The Eco Industrial Parks/Estates include aspects such as judicious siting of industries, proper designing of the site with grouping of industries needed infrastructure, encouraging state-of-the-art manufacturing processes, waste minimization etc. and provide a very conducive environment both to the industries inside the estate and communities and other development/land uses around the estate. The pilot work on development of Eco Industrial Parks in Andhra Pradesh has been taken up by the Central Pollution Control Board for:

In the password protected Intranet all training and workshop related documents and presentation are managed by means of a "Content Management System". More than 130 courses, workshops and conferences are documented per year.

- to coordinate their training activities and contents
  - to document all material, reports, evaluations and tools

  - to guide the development of training programmes

- The Training Management Platform facilitates:**
- The efficient preparation of large scale capacity building programmes
  - A comprehensive documentation of status and outcomes through easy to handle tools (e.g. reporting, documentation, training evaluation and impact analysis)
  - Access to reports, participants lists and background information for authorised users
